OFFICIAL SHOW SCHEDULE

STANDARD BREED CLASSES (1-60)

All classes apply to the cavy's age on the day of the show:

- A Boar (12 months and over)
- B Sow (12 months and over)
- I Intermediate (9 months to under 12 months)
- C Junior (6 to under 9 months)
- **D Baby** (3 to under 6 months)

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS (Classes 54 - 60)

Cavies must be prepared and exhibited by an ANCC Affiliated member under the age of eighteen. These cavies must also be entered in the corresponding general class.

MEMBERS PET CLASS (Class 53)

Definition of a Pet is a cavy that does not meet the standards of the breed and is not being shown in a Breed Class

UNSTANDARDISED (Class 52)

This class is for new breeds that have been granted a 'Working Title' by the ANCC Standards Review Panel, but do not have a recognised standard. They are presented to the judges for discussion and are not judged. No awards are given. There is no entry fee for these breeds.

ENTRY FORM

Entry forms must include:

– Date of birth, sex and breed details for every animal except Coarse Coat and Longhair breeds (breed only; not colour). Cavies entered without a birth date will be placed in the Adult Section. This may have a negative impact on the judging of your cavy. Changes will not be accepted at the judging table and no entries are to be corrected without prior confirmation from the entries secretary.

ENTRIES

Entries close the Friday prior to the show unless otherwise stated. Late entries will be taken at the discretion of the entry secretary.

PAYMENT

Entries can be paid online or on the day at the show.

EXHIBITION

Halls are open for set up at 8.00 am.

All Exhibitors must collect their eartags and have their entries and scratchings confirmed with the entries secretary prior to 9.00 am, ready for judging to commence at 9.30am. Exhibitors must be financial members of an ANCC affiliated cavy club. Show boards (no higher than 5cm) or carpet squares (approximately 30cm X 30cm) are required for each cavy.

TRESTLE TABLES

There are a limited number of tables and chairs at most halls. If you have your own you may want to bring them along.

JUDGING

The judge's decision is FINAL and no correspondence will be entered into. No judge or the immediate family of a judge may exhibit at a show at which they are judging the General Classes. A cavy purchased from a judge may not be exhibited under that judge until a period of 3 months has elapsed. No talking is permitted at the judging table. Any communications must be left until after the judging of that class has concluded. Any exhibitor making comments about other animals may risk their animal being disqualified.

CARRY CAGE BEDDING

GSCC recommends the use of Back-2-Nature small animal bedding & litter for cavies Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their own area before leaving.

SELLING OF CAVIES AT SHOWS

Members of the club are permitted to sell cavies at shows, with \$30 being the minimum selling price for each cavy. They must be in good health and free from parasites. Cavies for sale may not be heavily pregnant or under 4 weeks of age without their mother. All babies sold should be properly weaned and eating independently. The following must be included for the buyer:

- Your contact details, the cavies sex, DOB and breed.
- Samples of the usual food, basic cavy care instructions and diet information and an indication on whether or not they are showable.
